- At the end of the course the participant will complete an exit evaluation and participate in an exit interview, take accountability for their role in the abuse and/or neglect their children endured, and identify ways to minimize risks in the future.
- The ability for an individual to participate in the class may be revisited if there are issues that arise in the class that could harm the safety and learning environment for participants and teachers alike.
- A letter will be provided to the referring agency detailing participation and observations within class as well as a copy of the exit evaluation.
